

Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH)

Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and restriction of Chemicals, or REACH, consists of legislative framework developed by the European Union to manage the risks that chemicals may pose to human health and the environment. This framework requires industry to register chemicals used in their products with the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA).

Supra Alloys is not a manufacturer. A review of REACH and Article 7 Paragraph 1 lead us to understand the classification of Supra Alloys as a supplier of Articles with no intended release of the chemicals contained within those Articles under normal or reasonably foreseeable conditions.

Supra Alloys distributes the Articles providing value added services such as saw cutting, slitting, shearing, chemical etching, grinding, heat treating and testing.

Our vendors continue to assess and monitor the REACH requirements as they pertain to the products they manufacture and the Articles we sell. As of this date, our vendors have determined that the products sold to Supra Alloys do not contain any significant amounts of chemical compounds on the Candidate List of Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC). Therefore, these products are considered compliant with European Union SVHC regulations.

Supra Alloys will continue to monitor our supply chain for REACH compliance.
